The State FDA Goa shall also in the coming months also launch the actual project of **Safe and Nutritious Food @ Home** and **Safe and Nutritious Food @ Schools** along with the initiative planned for the consumer awareness of these food safety and the feedback of the consumer concerned management under the initiative of **Connect @ Citizens**;
